

Shelter-in-place is an occupant protection strategy that may be issued in response to a variety of incidences involving severe weather, violent behavior, outside chemical releases and other situations where it is safer for building occupants to remain in the sheltered area of a building. Thus, to "shelter-in-place" means to take refuge inside the nearest structure.

To Shelter-in-Place

- If inside and in a safe location, stay where you are
- If outdoors, seek nearest University building
- Locate an interior room to shelter inside.
- Shut windows, vents and close exterior doors
- Stay in place until directed by ENS message and/or emergency personnel
